

Parent-Visitors at Hillis

Parent visitors are welcome to join their child(ren)at lunch and recess times during the school day. For specific lunch and recess times, please contact your child's homeroom teacher. We ask that parent visitors not visit classrooms



Change in dismissal plans.

If you have a dismissal plan different than what is a regular routine for your child (example you are picking up your student and he or she should not ride the bus), please contact the main office (515.242.8412) by 2:00pm. We want to safely ensure the change of plan is enacted and need to have information before 2:00pm. Calls made after 2:00pm may not be carried out due to end of the day responsibilities. Thank you for your attention to this important safety matter for our children.

Attendance

Daily on time attendance to school makes a difference in student achievement. Students must be at school, in the building, by 7:45 am. Students who are dropped off at 7:45 am or after, are to be escorted into the main office and signed in to the building for the day. If a parent is wanting to walk a student to their classroom after 7:45 am, we ask that the parent sign in as a visitor and provide proof of identification by providing a valid driver's license for scanning. All visitors to Hillis must sign in and provide proof of identification for the safety of our children. Thank you for your support and assistance in keeping Hillis safe!

Dismissal

School dismisses at 2:40pm each day. Students must be picked up from school no later than 2:55pm as there is no staff available after 2:55pm. Students who are not picked up by 2:55pm will be placed in our school based after school program and parents will be assessed a fee.

Leader in Me

Hillis Elementary is a Leader in Me school! This year our school will be launching a "habit" of leadership each month during a school wide "Hillis Hound Pack Rally." Our first Hillis Hound Pack Rally is scheduled for September 8th at 8:00-8:30 am. Parents are welcome to attend.

At Hillis, we have been learning about ways we can re-charge or re-calibrate ourselves when we are feeling ways like nervous, anxious, or frustrated. Each learning space at Hillis has a "Paws Station". Hillis Paws Stations are areas that

have different things students can do to help them calm down and refocus. Ask your child(ren) how they have used the Paws Station and what helps promote a sense of calm for them? Homes can establish a Paws Station too!

All visitors (including parents) to Hillis must sign in at the office and provide proof of identification (this includes signing your child out early from school). All visitors will be processed through our T-Pass security system. Please allow a few minutes the first time you arrive as all visitors must be entered into our security system. Every visit after that you must still provide Identification at the main office desk. Thank you for your support and patience in keeping Hillis safe!
