As you may have heard, the Iowa School Performance Profiles were published by the State Department of Education on October 26, 2023. These profiles function as our school's "report card" for the State and Federal government. The state collects information throughout the school year and uses it to calculate a score for our school based on metrics that are required by State and Federal law – for our school, that includes:

Elementary/Middle/High: Assessment Participation on ISASP, Average School Achievement on ISASP, Conditions for Learning survey, Growth on ISASP, Percent Proficient on ISASP, Progress toward English Language Proficiency High School: Graduation Rate (4 year and 5 year), Postsecondary Readiness

The information used to calculate the Iowa School Performance Profile this year was collected during the 2022-2023 school year.

Here are a few key celebrations we identified as the result of our school's commitment to student learning:

- 1. Our student growth in English Language Arts is above the State of Iowa average growth.
- 2. Our Multi-Language learner's performance in English proficiency is above the State of Iowa average growth.
- 3. Our student's report the highest area of Conditions for Learning, is their relationship with their teacher. Students say their teachers really care about them.

Here are the areas we identified as opportunities for continued improvement at our school:

- 1. We are continuing to work on increasing literacy proficiency through our implementation of the EL curriculum and GLEAM practices.
- 2. We are continuing to work on increasing mathematic proficiency through our implementation of IM curriculum and GLEAM practices.
- 3. We are continuing to implement a core guidance program, building wide Leader in Me SEL core program and student to student relationships that will enhance our students social and emotional growth.

Our school always strives for continuous improvement, and this Performance Profile is just one tool in our tool belt for creating an environment where every student who comes to DMPS and to Hillis Elementary School becomes their best here.
